

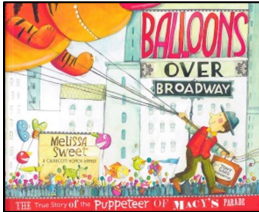

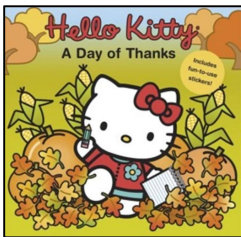

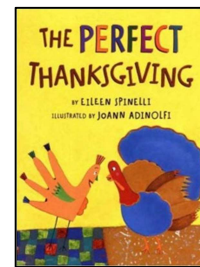
The Perfect Thanksgiving by Eileen Spinelli

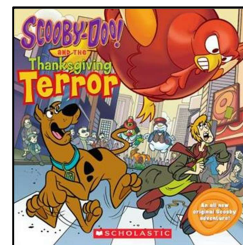


Pinkalicious: Thanksgiving Helper by Victoria Kann
